The investment objective of the U.S. Small Cap Value Portfolio is to achieve long-term capital appreciation.

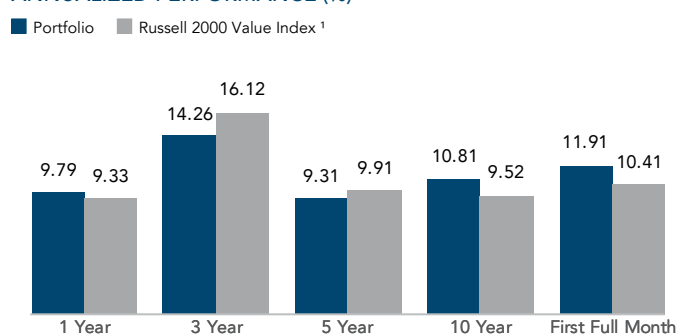
