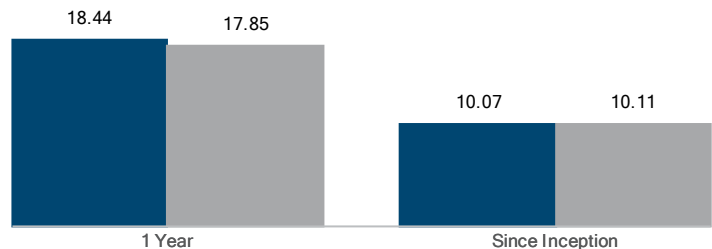
## PRINCIPAL RISKS

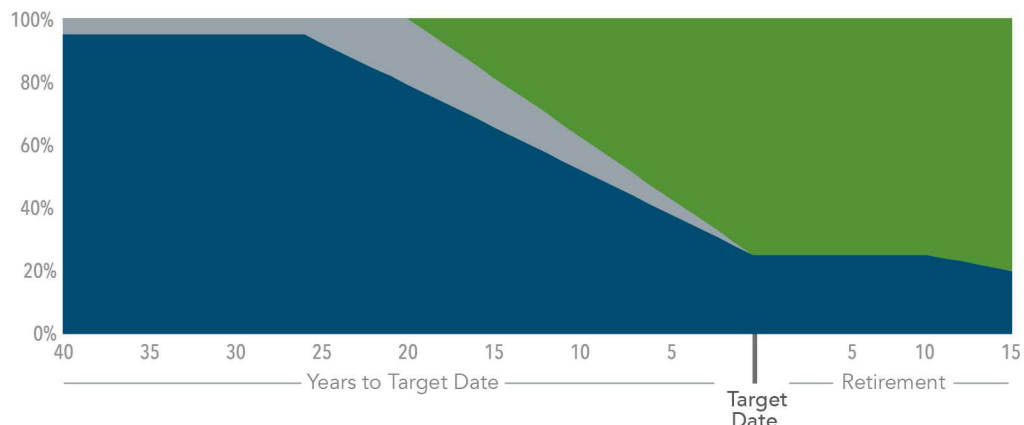
